ADDENDUM FIVE

The contract documents for the above referenced project, dated July 20, 2011 are amended as follows:

CLARIFICATION

1. In regards to the bid acceptance, will the DBE percentage on the bid be accepted on the base bid and amended after award if alternates are taken?
Answer: The DBE goal will be assessed on the percentages achieved in the base bid. The selection of alternates will not have an adverse effect on the award of the bid to the successful Contractor.
2. Please clarify the allowances ARE to be included in the base bid and the allowance for Allowance No. 1 (furnishing and installing PVC liner) is \$30,000 as stated in the allowance section of the specifications.
Answer: Allowances are to be included in the base bid. The amount for the PVC liner of \$30,000 was removed in Addendum #1. The Contractor shall calculate their cost to furnish and install the liner as required in the drawings and specification and include that amount on the Bid Form.
3. Please send any information regarding the wage rates for concrete and masonry construction.
Answer: See Maryland Wage General Decision issued via this addendum.
4. Please confirm that the (2)3" conduits specified on Drawing E300 per note #4 are not part of this contract.
Answer: (2)-3" conduits are not part of this contract. Contractor awarded the TCC Maintenance Building project will furnish and install these conduits.
5. Please clarify the scope of work related to note #1 on Drawing E300. Are we to provide and install (1) 1" conduit from a weatherproof junction box to the maintenance building or to the scope of work line?
Answer: See sketch SKE-2 dated 08/17/11 issued via this addendum.. Phasing line has been relocated to include the installation of motorized gate and security camera in the TCC Maintenance Building project. These conduits and boxes will not be installed under this project contract.
6. Please clarify the scope of work related to the power circuit SB-15 shown near the Fare Drop location.
Answer: Circuit SB-15 is for power to the motorized gate that will now be included in the TCC Maintenance Building project per changes made in sketch SKE-2.

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Unlisted classifications needed for work not included within the scope of the classifications listed may be added after award only as provided in the labor standards contract clauses (29 CFR 5.5(a)(1)(ii)).

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In the listing above, the "SU" designation means that rates listed under the identifier do not reflect collectively bargained wage and fringe benefit rates. Other designations indicate unions whose rates have been determined to be prevailing.

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WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator (See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7).

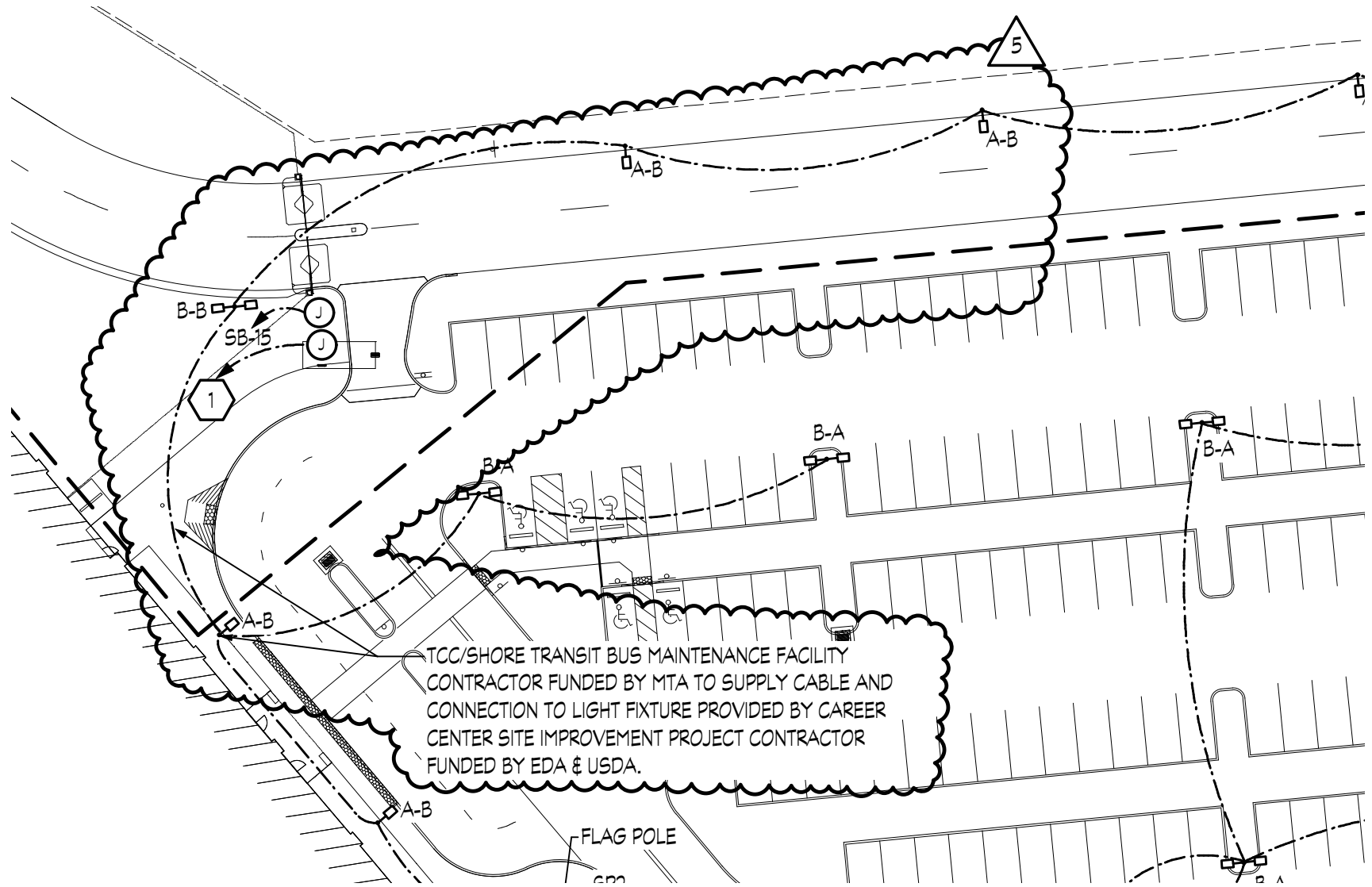
The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:

4.) All decisions by the Administrative Review Board are final.
